The conditions of eligibility are as under: -

- The student must be studying in class IX or X on a full-time basis.
- 2. The Scholarship is applicable to students with disabilities with 40% and above and having a valid certificate of disability. Disability is defined in "Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016".
- 3. Scholarship award will be sanctioned in the case of students whose parent's/guardian's income from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000/per annum.
- 4. Income Certificate issued by Competent Authority is required to be taken once i.e., at the time of admission to the course.
- 5. A scholarship holder under the scheme will not hold any other educational scholarship for the purpose of studying in class IX and X. If awarded, the student will avail either of the 02 scholarships as per his/her choice and must inform the awarding authority to the Head of the Institution about the option made.
